

WESTMONT COLLEGE DOG POLICY

Because of issues related to health, safety, and College liability (and consistent with county regulations), no dogs are allowed on Westmont athletic fields, and must be leashed when outdoors on other parts of the campus; and no dogs are allowed in Westmont's food service areas, classrooms and other indoor public areas, with the exception of seeing eye dogs, and of therapy dogs approved by the Executive Team. When owners bring their dogs to campus, they are asked to consider the well-being of others and are required to clean up after their dogs. The College reserves the right to ban a dog from campus and to hold the owner financially liable for any damage or cleaning costs. Complaints and concerns about a dog brought to campus by a staff or faculty member may be communicated to the office of Human Resources, the Provost, or Student Life.
