Proposed addition to section 2.1.1.2 Special Status Faculty:

2.1.1.2.5 Fellows

A Fellow of Westmont College is a limited-term appointment made by the Provost to individuals whose work is expected to contribute in some substantial way to the academic, spiritual, and/or cultural life of the college community. Typically, fellows are appointed in connection with a specific academic department, program, or college institute. Normally, appointments are for up to one year; additional appointments are possible. Fellows are granted faculty library privileges and work/study space (as available). Fellows need not be in residence at Westmont's home campus.
