Sections may be **Open, Closed or Waitlisted.** **Waitlisted is the same as Closed.**

Students on the waitlist must go to the class during the first week of the semester to see if space is available. They must obtain the instructor's signature on an add/drop form and then bring the add/drop form to the Student Records Office in Kerrwood Hall to register for the course section.
