

## ***Admitted Student Days Frequently Asked Questions***

### **Is there a cost for students? What does it include?**

*The \$15 cost covers student meals while on campus and overnight accommodations. You can pay by credit card during online registration or with cash or check when you arrive on campus.*

### **Where will I stay?**

*Students planning on staying overnight will be matched with a current Westmont student for a night in a dorm room. Students are typically housed in the first year dorms Page or Clark.*

### **Can I request a host or a dorm?**

*Yes! If you would like to stay in a certain dorm on campus or know a student you would like to stay with, please make a note of it in the appropriate section when you register online.*

### **What should I bring to campus?**

*Overnight guests should plan on bringing a sleeping bag and pillow, towel, toiletries, and other personal belongings. Meals are covered in the cost.*

### **What if I want to have an audition or visit with a coach or professor during Admitted Student Days?**

*Auditions and individual meetings are always encouraged during campus visits. It is best to directly contact the department you are interested in. Contact information for some of our more frequently requested departments is listed below:*

### **Can I be picked up from the airport, train station, or bus station?**

*We are able to pick up students traveling without family members from the Santa Barbara airport, Amtrak station, and Greyhound bus stop. Rental cars are available at the airport for students traveling with family members. If you will need us to pick you up from one of these locations, please let us know full travel details **at least a week in advance**.*

### **What if I plan on arriving on campus late?**

*We request notification of late arrivals. The Registration table will be open on the Page Hall Patio all afternoon and late check in is available from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm in Kerrwood Hall.*

### **Do I need a parking permit?**

*A permit is not required to park on campus and cars are allowed to stay on campus overnight.*

*Now that you have been admitted to Westmont, your questions are most likely different than when you first began the college search process. Admitted Student Days is an opportunity for you to ask those questions and look at Westmont through a different lens while learning more about what it means to be a part of the Westmont community academically, spiritually, and socially.*

**I can only come for one of the two days. Which day should I attend?**

*If you are only able to come for one day of our two day event, you are still welcome to attend. Thursday is the more informational and social side of the visit, while Friday represents more of what it would be like to be a Westmont student. If you are only able to attend on Friday, please plan on arriving by 7:30 am in order to have a full day experience. Both days are equally informative and the day you choose to attend depends greatly upon your availability and what you hope to get out of your visit to campus. If you are only coming for just one day, please let us know which day so we know what type of arrangements to make for you.*

**Are parents able to attend? What sessions are available for them?**

*Parents are invited and encouraged to attend. Unless otherwise noted on the schedule, all sessions are open for parents to attend. Please see the parent schedule for further details.*

**Is there a cost for parents to attend?**

*There is no cost for parents to attend, however dinner meals in the Dining Commons will be \$10 per person. You can pay for dinner at the event.*

**Where should parents stay?**
