Section 1. Title

Off-Campus Students Like Baseball Too Act

Section 2. Statement of Purpose

This bill will sponsor up to 20 Off-Campus/no-meal plan students to attend the World Series Ballpark Dinner Night in the DC Wednesday Evening (10/25).

Section 3. Statement of Policy

1. Up to a total of \$140.00-- whereas dinner will be discounted to \$7 a person granted they display a valid Westmont ID-- will be appropriated for the enactment of this bill toward the end of expressing our interest in facilitating community for those autonomous and industrious students who cook for themselves everyday.
2. In partnership with Sodexo and Bill Groeneveld, Associate Director of Procurement and Contracts;
 1. The names of students without meal-plans who express interest in free food, fellowship, and America's favorite pastime shall be procured via electronic solicitation the night of October 24 and the morning of October 25—
 2. Following the acquisition of up to 20 names, this list will be provided to Bill Groeneveld before 11:00am on October 25th, allowing this select group of students to enjoy the wonders of our Dining Commons for free, therefore proving true the common idiom that there is indeed no such thing as a free lunch, but at Westmont, there *is* such a thing as a free dinner.

Section 4. Enactment

1. Upon the passage of this bill, the Westmont College Student Association will appropriate up to \$140.00 to Sodexo, facilitated by Bill Groeneveld (upon presentation of a receipt).
