Section 1. Title

*Presidential Prerogative Publicity Act
(WCSA Swag Bill 2.0)*

Section 2. Statement of Purpose

Whereas in light of President Benjamin Peterson's relaying the information of the failure of the WCSA Swag bill by 3 votes to Westmont college president Dr. Beebe.

And whereas the President of Westmont College, Dr. Beebe, would like to assist WCSA in purchasing shirts and believes this will be a great way of publicizing Student Government.

And whereas Dr. Beebe has stated it is his presidential prerogative to help fund the purchase of these shirts,

1. This bill will fund the purchase of half of the long sleeve shirts with the money from President Beebe.
2. This bill will allow WCSA to gain more exposure to the student body and clearly demarcate the members of the WCSA team.
3. Senator Anderson will be purchasing shirts and WCSA will pay for half of the base price of the shirts with half of the funding coming from WCSA team member's pockets.
4. This price is not extravagant as compared to the spending of other Student Organizations on similar kinds of expenditures. For example,
 - a. Urban Initiative in the 2017-18 year spent \$12 on each shirt for their core team.¹
 - b. Potters Clay in the 2017-18 year spent \$32 on each sweatshirt for their core team.²
 - c. Westmont Activities Council in the 2017-18 year spent \$XXX on each Patagonia sweatshirt for their team.³

- d. Emmaus Road in the 2017-18 year spent \$40 on each sweatshirt for their team.⁴

Section 3. Statement of Policy

1. The T-shirts are \$22.64 a piece at the base price so WCSA shall pay for \$11.32 per T-shirt.
2. In total WCSA will pay \$190 with the rest coming from the team members pockets.
3. One of the T-shirts will be paid in full by WCSA for the Director of Campus Life, Dr. Angela D'Amour.

Section 4. Enactment

1. Upon the passage of this bill the Business Manager, Cecil Rutherford III, will appropriate \$190 to refund Senator Anderson for the purchase of the shirts.
