#### **Section 1. Title**

*An Evening with Westmont Alumna and California State Assembly member Kristin Olsen Act of 2014*

#### **Sections 2. Statement of Purpose**

This bill proposes to schedule an evening event with Westmont Alumni of the Year, Assemblywoman Kristin Olsen, during her visit to campus on Friday, October 17, 2014. This would provide an opportunity for all students to hear from a former student of the Westmont community and current leader in the California State Assembly. Additionally, there will be a chance to have an intimate and private dinner with the Assemblywoman and her family for members of WCSA. If enacted, this bill will put into motion the planning of the event as well as provide funding for the meal.

#### **Section 3. Statement of Policy**

- (1) A one-time funding request for a dinner event with Assemblywoman Olsen and the WCSA team.

(2) Senator Hopper and Senator Fuller will work to get the event planned, book the appropriate location for the event, and advertise to the student body about the opportunity to hear Assemblywoman Olsen speak.

(3) To take place on Friday, October 17, 2014 from 6:15-8:30 PM. The location for the event is still to be determined.

(4) Meal attendees would include Assemblywoman Kristin Olsen; her husband, Rob Olsen; WCSA Executive Team; WCSA Senate; President and Mrs. Beebe; Angela D'Amour; and Myvy Ngo. Up to 4 possible attendees may also include the children of Assemblywoman Olsen and staff.

#### **Section 4. Enactment**

If enacted, Senator Hopper and Senator Fuller will work to coordinate the event and inform Assemblywoman Olsen and her staff of the event details before Thursday, October 9, 2014.

#### **Section 5. Appropriation**

Funds to be appropriated as necessary to cover the total bill, and a \$30.00 cap per student will apply.
