Position Replacement Request: Mathematics

Rationale:

Ray Rosentrater has announced his plans to retire as soon as an acceptable replacement is found, but will stay in any case a maximum of three more years. With Ray in place we still have required adjunct hiring of one or two courses per semester. The benefit of continuing this faculty line amounts to filling most of our courses with faculty trained at the Ph.D. level, and who have a vested interest in promoting Westmont's mission. If this position were not continued we would have to staff an additional six courses per year with even more adjunct positions and/or cancel course offerings.

Job Description:

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Westmont College is seeking a full-time tenure-track faculty member. Applicants must hold the Ph.D. degree in either mathematics, applied mathematics, or statistics, demonstrate a love for teaching and research, and fully subscribe to the mission of Westmont College as a Christian undergraduate liberal arts institution.
