

Academic Probation

- After Fall semester
 - o we have 31 enrolled students on academic probation (26 or 84% are from the 2020 student cohort)
 - o 7 students were suspended and reinstated (all from 2019 cohort except 1 transfer student who started in Jan 2020)
 - 5 students went on probation after Fall but did not return (4 or 80% were from 2020 student cohort)
 - o 3 students were suspended after Fall and did not to return



- Of 30 first semester students that ended up on probation after Fall 2020
 - \circ 50% had no leading indicators; 30% had 1; 20% had 2; 0 had all 3
 - o 9 (30%) were HABH students; 5 (17%) were FG; 7 (23%) were LAP
