

**STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW  
GRADUATION RATES FOR 2014 FIRST TIME FIRST SEMESTER COHORT**

The Federal government calculates graduation rates based off of the number of students who graduate within 150% of the time it would take to earn a degree. Since a bachelors degree is a four year degree, the graduation rates below are for the 2014 entering cohort of students who completed their degree within six years by the summer of 2020.

The cohort for the 2014 entering class of first time first semester freshman consisted of 375 students.  
The six year graduation rate for the cohort was 71.7%
