

**STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW
GRADUATION RATES FOR 2015 FIRST TIME FIRST SEMESTER COHORT**

The Federal government calculates graduation rates based off of the number of students who graduate within 150% of the time it would take to earn a degree. Since a bachelors degree is a four year degree, the graduation rates below are for the 2015 entering cohort of students who completed their degree within six years by the summer of 2021.

The cohort for the 2015 entering class of first time first semester freshman consisted of 339 students.
The six year graduation rate for the cohort was 73.5%
