This screen will give you important information about each course.



This includes whether the course is open or closed, the section name and number, if there are additional fees for the course (the +\$ symbol), the title of the course and the day, time and location of each class meeting.

It also shows the instructors name, the course availability (the first number is the number of seats available) and whether it meets any General Education requirements.

Be sure to read the comments for any course you consider, as they give important information about the course.
