Important Notice
The following notification is made in compliance with recently passed legislation in California (AB 2248): Certain forms of financial aid, including (but not limited to) Cal Grants and Westmont College grants and scholarships, are limited to four academic years (eight semesters). Please note that students need to take an average of 15.5 units per semester (16 units for the Bachelor of Music Education program) in order to graduate within four years. Entering first-year students are encouraged to limit their courseload to 13 units in the fall semester of their first year and then take additional units in subsequent semesters to get to the average of number of units needed to complete the degree within four years. Note that courses taken during Mayterm, a summer term, or at your local community college and transferred to Westmont can also be used to ensure that you complete your academic program within four years. Note, too, that the duration of eligibility for Westmont College grants and scholarships is prorated for transfer students, based on the number of units being transferred to Westmont and taken prior to the first semester of enrollment at Westmont.


