#### Rationale:

Chandra Mallampalli is leaving Westmont Summer 2023. This search is to "replace" Chandra. Every academic year the History department teaches 10-11 sections of Christian Perspectives on World History (HIS 010), a Common Contexts GE course. Without this position that burden on the remaining three non-US history professors would be untenable. One of the strengths of the History Department is the global dimension of our History courses. Outside of off campus programs, the History is a primary location for courses that focus on regions of the world outside the United States and Europe within the Westmont curriculum. In light of Westmont's commitment to international and global education, retaining that strength within the History department seems important.

#### **Position Job Description**

Westmont College invites applications for a tenure-track position in non-Western History at the rank of assistant or associate professor. We are open to any area of geographical concentration outside of North America, Europe, and the Middle East. With a teaching load of three courses per semester, the candidate is expected to teach several sections of a GE core course on World History since 1350 as well as upper division courses in his or her field of specialization.

Westmont College, a liberal arts college in the Protestant evangelical tradition, seeks faculty who are committed to teaching and mentoring undergraduates, to advancing a program of scholarly activity, and to advancing our mission of Christian liberal arts education. With the changing demographics of our region, many of our students now identify as non-white, and we are especially interested in faculty who are able to support and encourage students of color.

Review of applications will begin [ October 15, 2022 ] and will continue until the position is filled.
