#### **Westmont Shines in Latest Rankings**

For more than two decades, U.S. News and World Report's Best Colleges has listed Westmont as one of the top 10 liberal arts colleges in California. Overall, Westmont continues to be one of the top two nationally ranked members of the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities.

Westmont is a top performer on the U.S. News Social Mobility ranking, which measures how well schools enrolled and graduated students who received federal Pell Grants. U.S. News also included Westmont in its national rankings of Best Undergraduate Economic Programs.

Westmont's U.S. News score improved in faculty salary, student-to-faculty ratio (11:1), financial resources and Pell Grant graduation rate.

## GAIN AN AFFORDABLE EDUCATION

We want to work with you to make college affordable. Westmont provided \$39 million in grants

and scholarships last year, assisting 95 percent of our students. Money's 2024 Best Colleges rating, which analyzed more than 700 four-year colleges with a focus on quality, affordability and student outcomes, recognized Westmont with four-out-of-five stars. LendEDU ranks Westmont highly in California for helping students afford tuition. Our four-year graduation rate (72 percent) exceeds the four-year national graduation rate (48 percent) by 24 percentage points and the six-year national graduation rate (64 percent) by eight percentage points. Twenty-one percent of Westmont students graduate early.
