Westmont Baseball earned its highest NCAA Division II national ranking in program history.

In 2024, nearly 10,000 college athletes nationwide (34%) entered the NCAA Transfer Portal. At Westmont, only 13 of 277 student-athletes transferred, resulting in a retention rate of over 95%.
