Assembly Bill (AB) 130 (Chap. 44, Stats. 2021) was signed by the Governor and became effective July 9, 2021. b. For Multiple Subject credentials, the major must be in Liberal Studies.

Applicants must complete and submit this form along with an **unofficial copy of their bachelor's degree transcript noting degree awarded or conferred** to the appropriate link for your credential type in the attached instructions for review and approval. Official transcripts will be required prior to recommendation of the credential requested. Submit this form and all supporting documentation in one PDF. Incomplete forms will be returned. Preliminary credential approval of SMC is subject to review and approval by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
