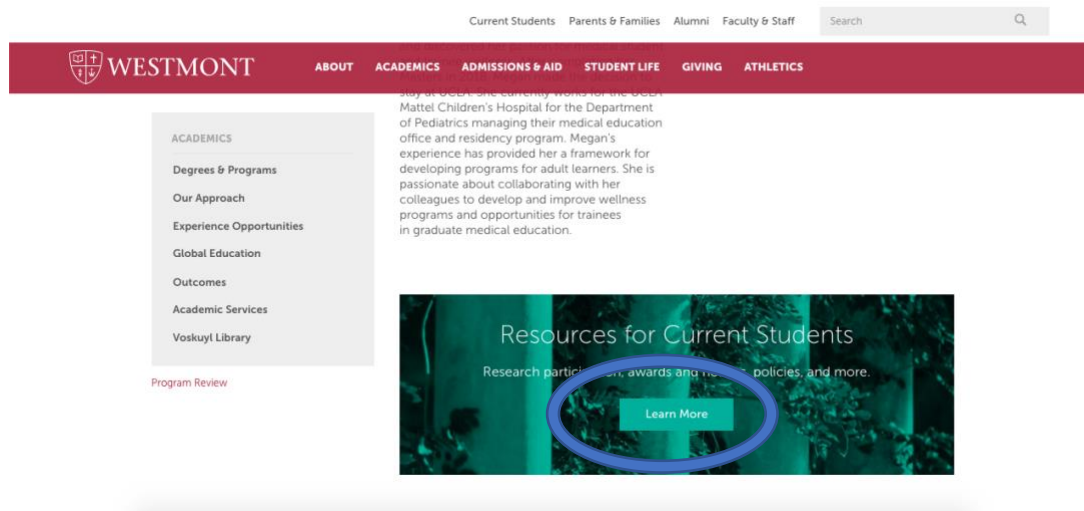
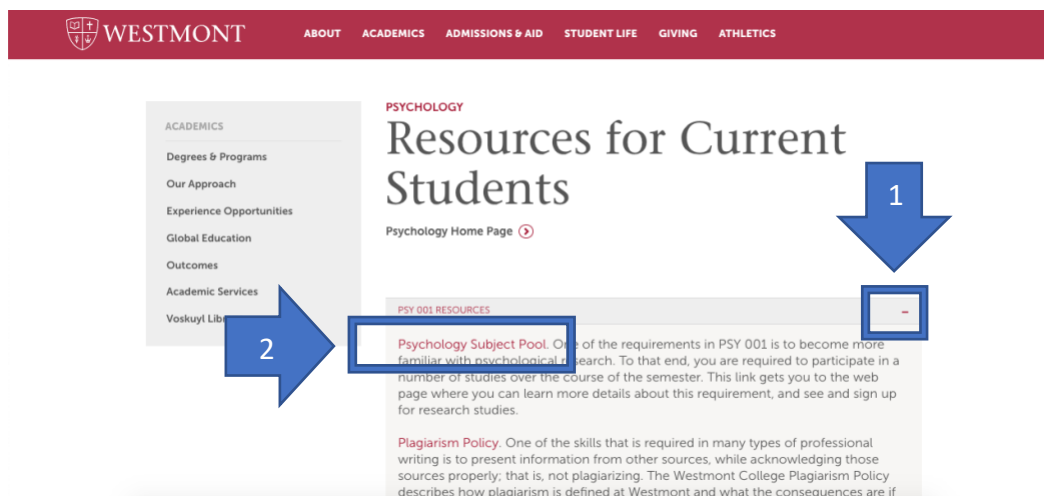


# PSY-001 Research Credit Sign-Up Instructions

## FINDING THE SUBJECT POOL



- Go to the Westmont Psychology Website and scroll to the bottom.
- In the box titled “Resources for Current Students” click on the “Learn More” button.



- On the “Resources for Current Students” page, click on the plus sign next to “PSY-001 Resources.”
- In the dropdown-list, click on “Psychology Subject Pool.”
