Appointment Basics

- **If you are new to WOnline**, please register for an account by clicking the link to the left.
- Appointments of 30-60 minutes will appear on the schedule as white boxes. **Click on the appointment time you want**, then enter basic information about your writing project and tutorial goals.
 - PRO TIP: If you have a draft of your writing project (no matter how rough), **attach a copy of your draft** when you make an appointment. If time allows, a tutor can look over your work before you arrive and can make better use of your appointment time.

Advanced Appointment Options

- Tutors have a variety of academic interests; all tutors are excellent writers who have been recommended and trained by our faculty.
- **To search for a tutor whose academic interests match your current writing assignment** (e.g., "English" or "Political Science"), select that focus from the "Limit to" drop-down menu after you log on.
- **If you have a multilingual background** and would like to work with one of our ESL/multilingual tutors, select that focus from the "Limit to" drop-down menu after you log on.

Online tutorials

- **Until further notice, all Writers' Corner tutoring appointments are being conducted ONLINE ONLY**, not in Voskuyl Library 215.
- **Shortly before your appointment time (in Pacific Standard Time)**, log in to westmont.mywconline.com, click on your appointment, and then select the red "start or join online consultation" link.
- **During an online tutorial**, you and your tutor can use a text chat, document-sharing whiteboard area, drawing tools, math tools, and audio/video. Even if you do not have audio or video capability on your electronic device, you can "talk" with your tutor via text chat after sharing your document (essay, etc.) with them.
