1. Armington Welcome Back Celebration Bill

# **Section 2. Statement of Purpose**

1. This bill will provide up to \$500 (\$100 of which to come from Senator Huff's Hall fund) to help contribute to the planned Welcome-Back Dinner to be catered by Mony's Tacos. This dinner is designed to be a community building event that welcomes back the displaced students, shows gratitude to those who hosted said displaced students, and encourages non-displaced Armington residents to warmly receive both of the aforementioned groups.

## **Section 3. Statement of Policy**

- 1. A total of up to \$500 will be appropriated for the enactment of this bill due to reasons and purpose stated above.
- 2. The \$500 will contribute alongside funds from Residence Life and the President's Office to cater the event, purchase decorations, and provide welcome-back baskets for students moving back in.

## **Section 4. Enactment**

- 1. Upon the approval and passage of this bill, the Westmont College Student Association by means of Business Manager Benjamin Meyers will transfer up to \$500 to Armington Hall account as managed by Tim Miller.
- 2. The funds will be used alongside those provided by Residence Life and the President's Office on an as needed-basis. The amount utilized is not to exceed \$500 (\$100 of which comes from Senator Huff's Hall funding)
