#### **Section 1. Title**

Spring Cleaning GLC KITCHEN EDITION

## **Sections 2. Statement of Purpose**

The GLC residents have long bemoaned the unfortunate lack of accountability for kitchen cleaning responsibilities. Despite the help of several student and staff workers, our community continues to struggle to keep the kitchens presentable (and/or usable). This bill allows for the proper incentive for an end-of-year kitchen cleaning competition: the reward of a pizza party for the winning section (approximately 45 residents).

To earn this reward, residents of each section will need to demonstrate consistent responsibility and prioritize the welfare of the community over their own convenience. Sections will be judged by our custodian as well as 2 anonymous judges, who will complete walkthroughs of each kitchen on a random day of the week for the remainder of the semester. The winning section will be invited to attend a pizza party for the Thursday before finals week.

#### **Section 3. Statement of Policy**

- 1. A total of \$160 will be appropriated for the purchase and delivery of 5 large cheese and 5 large pepperoni pizzas from Domino's, to be delivered to the winning section of the GLC.
- 2. A total of \$10 will be appropriated for the purchase of 4 2L bottles of soda.

# Section 4. Enactment & Appropriation

Upon the approval and passage of this bill, WCSA will allocate \$170 to Kennedy Mahdavi for the purchase of supplies listed above. The specified amount will be allocated no later than Tuesday, April 24th, prior to the pizza party (to be held on Thursday, 4/27/18).
