Though live performance auditions & design/technology interviews are preferred, during the Covid-19 pandemic, we are not allowing in person auditions or interviews. Please send your resume, this completed form, and the below audition or design/technology materials to theatre@westmont.edu.

A performance audition video link (YouTube, Vimeo, etc.) is required and should consist of the following:

- **A slate (name, hometown, and pieces you will be doing)**
- **Two monologues (one classical/one contemporary)**
- **16 bars of a song (optional: if you sing)**
- **A short movement sequence (optional: if you dance)**

Your total audition link should not exceed 4 minutes for monologues, and 5 minutes if you add singing and/or movement. Please do NOT send full-length shows or clips of your previous productions. Only audition video links that follow the above requirements will be viewed.

A design/technology portfolio (Google Slide, PowerPoint, etc.) is required and should consist of the following:

- **One production book (paper work, forms, design development)**
- **Images of completed production work**

Please include one letter of recommendation from a design/technology teacher, mentor or employer.
