Go to http://www.irs.gov/Individuals/Get-Transcript to set up an account and obtain your transcript. If you are unable to set up an account online, you may print out, complete, and fax or mail to the IRS **Form 4506-T Request for Transcript of Tax Return**, found at https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f4506f.pdf, to receive it by mail (check box 6a to request a Return Transcript).

A **Verification of Non-filing Letter** is required to show that a student or spouse was not required to file taxes in 2017. The letter can be printed or saved to your computer directly from the IRS website. Go to http://www.irs.gov/Individuals/Get-Transcript to set up an account and obtain your Non-filing Letter. If you are unable to set up an account online, you may print out, complete and fax or mail the IRS **Form 4506-T Request for Transcript of Tax Return**, found at https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f4506f.pdf, to receive it by mail (check box 7 to request Verification of Non-filing).
